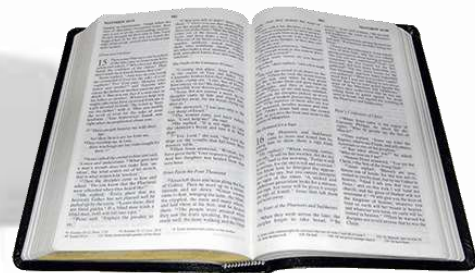

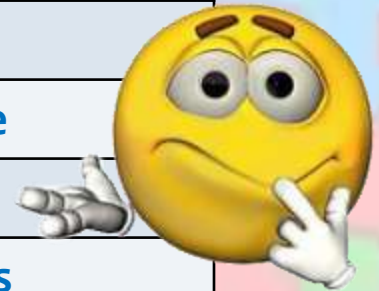

& “was” (H1961) in Gen 1:2

- Gen 1:2 is the first time the word “was” is used in Scripture.
- The word “was” can cause confusion for the proper understanding of the context.
- The Hermeneutic principle of ... “first word usage takes the first dictionary definition” does not seem to hold true for this word “was” this time.
- Why does “was” have to take another definition to fit the proper context of verse 2?



H1961 is “**hayah**”

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Is it possible H1961 has something to do with the Sacred Name?

“was” (H1961) is “hayah”

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Is it probable - a short investigation of Sacred Name will solve the “was” confusion?

Matt 1:21 ... thou shalt call his name JESUS (G2424) ...

- Iesous (ee-ay-sooce'); of Hebrew origin [H3091]; Jesus (i.e. Jehoshua), the name of our Lord [Master]...
- H3091 Yehowshuwa' (yeh-ho-shoo'-ah); or Yehowshu' a (yeh-ho-shoo'-ah); from H3068 and H3467; [Yahuah-saved] Jehovah-saved; Jehoshua (i.e. Joshua).
- Yahusha (the Son) means Yahuah-Saved.

H3091 Yahusha from H3068 & H3467

H3068 points to Yahuah:

- **H3068** Yehovah (yeh-ho-vaw');
from **H1961**; (the) **self-Existent or Eternal**; Jehovah, Jewish national name of God [Elohim].

- **H3467** yasha' (yaw-shah');
a primitive root; properly,
to be open, wide or free, i.e.
(by implication) to be safe;
causatively, to free or succor:
KJV - at all, avenging, **defend**,
deliver (-er), help, preserve,
rescue, be safe, **bring** (having)
salvation, save (-iour), get victory.

➤ **H1961** hayah (haw-yaw);
a primitive root [compare H1933];
[1st def.] to exist,
[2nd def.] i.e. be or become,
[3rd def.] come to pass

* **H1933** hava' (haw-vaw'); or
havah (haw-vaw'); a primitive root
[compare H183, **H1961**]
supposed to mean properly,
to breathe; to be (**in the sense
of existence**): KJV - be, have.

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A Closer Look at H1961 [hayah]

➤ **H1961** hayah (haw-yaw); a primitive root

[Review: compare **H1933** hava'; supposed to mean properly,
to breathe; to be in the sense of existence]

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Note: H1933 hava'; meaning to breathe; or be in the sense of existence
appears to apply to the 1st two definitions for H1961 as listed below.

[1st def.] to exist

[2nd def.] i.e. be or become

John 1:18 ... the only begotten Son,
which is in the bosom of the Father ... KJV

YAHUAH
(the Father)

YAHusha
(the Son)

Does it seem like the first two definitions of H1961 [hayah]
link back to Gen 1:1, the Creator of heaven and earth?

The 3rd Definition of H1961 [hayah]

- **H1961** hayah;
[3rd def.] come to pass; **came to be**
- **The 3rd definition is directly linked to Gen 1:2** “And the earth **came to be** without form, void, [with] darkness upon the face of the deep.”

Joshua Confirms Firstfruits Follows the **Passover** Sabbath

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The **Wavesheaf of Firstfruits** was waved on Abib 15, the day after the **weekly H7676 Sabbath!**

Joshua Confirms **Firstfruits** follows only
the H7676 weekly Sabbath – not the
1st Unleavened Bread Feast Sabbath!

Firstfruits never follows “days” linked
to the following Hebrew numbers:

- H2282 – Feast [Chag]
 - H6944 – Holy [Qodesh]
 - H4744 – Convocation [miqra]
- ✓ **The** 1st Sabbath of ULB on Abib 15
is always connected to
the Hebrew #s listed above.

Biblical Passover Placements:

1. Exodus 12 Passover on 3rd cycle (Tues)
2. Joshua Passover on 7th cycle (H7676 Sabbath)
3. Yahusha's Passover on 4th cycle (Wed) the "midst of the week"!

 Enoch has every Passover celebration on the 3rd cycle (Tues) of the week each year.

False Placements of Firstfruits

Joshua exposes:

1. The false teaching that Firstfruits must always be CELEBRATED ON ABIB 16!
2. The false teaching that Firstfruits always FOLLOWS THE 1ST UNLEAVENED BREAD SABBATH!
3. The false teaching of the Enoch Calendar that Firstfruits always FOLLOWS THE WEEKLY H7676 SABBATH OUTSIDE THE WEEK OF THE PASSOVER FESTIVAL!

QUESTION #2 WAS: Will **Day 33 of the Omer Count** land on Thursday **May 7, 2015** exactly like the Jewish calendar?

ANSWER:

This Christian Feast
Calendar does favor
the Jewish

LAG BA'OMER

which begins at

sunset on May 6th!

MAY 7TH IS THE 33RD DAY.

Christian Feast Keepers that follow this Jewish calendar likely do not know the 33rd day of the Omer count pays respect to the death of the great mystic sage Rashbi, who authored the most famous book of the Kabbalah ushering in Jewish mysticism.

The Torah commands of Moses are very clear on the placement of Firstfruits "when Israel entered the land." Joshua fulfilled those commands perfectly.

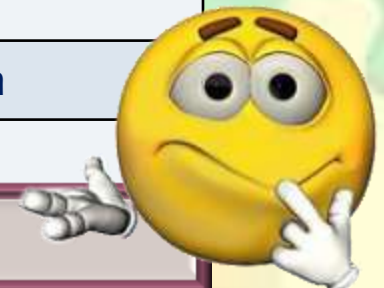
