


## Basic Pre-Summary From Part 1

Yahuah's requirements thus far:


- 1. Enter the land.

  - 3. Cut the First Wheat Wave Sheaf offering O
    - 4. Roast & Grind Wheat; prepare a Flour and Oil Mixture.
      - 5. Present the ascent offering (by fire) to Yahuah.
- - 6. Bake Bread Dough for normal consumption.
  - 7. Eat the Grain of the Land!

Only after the Wave Sheaf and the ascension offerings had been presented was it acceptable to Yahuah to consume the FIRST Grain of the Land! Jos 5:11 - ... AND THEY ATE ...






## Introduction

Justo ... what it must have been lmagined. like to finally smell the new grain and touch it!




Some feel Joshua allowed the people to process the old grain in order to have unleavened bread for the Passover meal ~ saving the new grain for the Wave Sheaf!

## Yisra'el Enjoys The Grain!



And they are of the stored grain of the land on the morrow after the Pesach, unleavened bread and roasted grain on the same day.

Josh 5:11

**ABIB 15** 

Abib 15 - 1st Cycle - 1st Convocation of U/B

No More Manna!

Abib 16

Josh 5:12 And the manna ceased on the day after they had eaten of the stored grain of the land. And the children of Yisra'el no longer had manna, but they ate the food of the land in Kena'an that year.

For Israel, who ate the grain of the land on Abib 15, there would be NO reason to look for manna on Abib 16 – the 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle of the week!

What about Enoch's calendar?

Remember Enoch's quote?

1/26: First Fruits (Waving of the Sheaf offering)

The <u>Sickle's FIRST Harvest</u>, as claimed by Enoch's calendar, asserts the Wave Sheaf offering of First Fruits (for the count to Shavuot) cannot be performed until Abib 26 (hungry or not)!

While Joshua was quite able to fulfill the

Torah's requirements concerning the

Feast of Unleavened Bread;

the rules of Enoch's Calendar would

have prevented Joshua from obedience

to Yahuah causing everyone to sin as well!



## This is Enoch's Dilemma ~ not Joshua's!

- 1. Enoch's harvest could not begin until Abib 26!
- 2. Enoch's people could not eat any grain until the Abib 26 harvest begins.
- 3. Enoch could not eat unleavened bread as commanded by Yahuah, during the Feast of Unleavened Bread! NO GRAIN & NO MANNA!
- 4. Enoch could only claim Abib 15 for eating manna. (Then what? Hunger?)
  Would that be one day of "Feast of Unleavened Manna" for ULB week?
- 5. Does Enoch believe the people should have been tempted by Yahuah to abstain from the coveted grain (which they had not eaten in 40 years) for 11 more days, (to Abib 26) before they could begin Enoch's harvest and satisfy their

hunger?

How many statutes have been broken?

## Section #4

If Joshua observed the Wave Sheaf Festival according to Enoch's calendar, what would be the condition of the bread if not offered until Abib 26?

What kind of problem will this create?

We now know there was a restriction for eating grain of any kind until after the Wave Sheaf had been presented. That's why ... Joshua performed the Wave Sheaf according to the statute, so they could eat the first batch of bread dough on Abib 15 - the morrow AFTER the H7676 Shabbat.

(Passover is not an "annual" Shabbat, but in this year Abib 14 was observed on the H7676 Shabbat.)

The People were then allowed to freely use the grain of the land!




Yahuah stipulated by statute the Wave Sheaf ceremony must occur on the 1st cycle of the week,

the **DAY** after the 7th day Shabbat.



## What is the difference between

It's the difference between a "date" and/or a "day."

## A "date" and/or a "day" are usually not the same!




Pandom Example:

a 4th cycle (or a Wednesday)


like it is on Enoch's calendar.



Joshua knew Torah's Wave Sheaf was always on the "day" after the H7676 Shabbat ~ whatever "date" that may be.



"Enoch" demands that <u>his</u> wave sheaf ceremony MUST be on a <u>certain DATE!</u>



The Enoch calendar claims the Wave Sheaf must be performed on <u>Abib 26</u> - not any other <u>date</u>. Therefore: If Enoch follows the Torah guidelines, <u>no grain can be touched until the Abib 26</u> Wave Sheaf.

Does this mean that Joshua broke the Torah statute by

defiantly eating the grain of the land on Abib 15 (Josh 5:11)?

Was Joshua really supposed to STORE A PORTION

of the FIRST batch of dough, until Abib 26-

11 cycles later - to honor Enoch's Wave Sheaf ceremony




Also we must remember (Lev 23:13) that the - oil mixed with flour is a DOUGH!

Review

Wave Sheaf had been presented according to statute.

There is no provision for a second Wave Sheaf ceremony according to Torah.


Abib 26th is a counterfeit from the Enoch calendar.

The Scriptures tell us unequivocally that presenting the Wave Sheaf <u>and</u> eating of grain of the land (bread) must be done consecutively, and "on the same day."

That's exactly what Joshua did on Abib 15.

Enoch claims the Wave Sheaf and eating of the bread is only performed on Abib 26!

How can "the same day"
be both
Abib 15, and 26?



#### Remember, Joshua declares:

By Torah Statute Abib 15 is always the
Unleavened Bread Festival.
When Wave Sheaf is also on Abib 15,
the ULB Festival is always celebrated
AFTER the Wave Sheaf Festival.

### Cutting Grain / Baking Bread / Eating

Joshua's duty:
1) Wavesheaf
2) bread dough
from 1st grain
offering
3) eat bread

Did Joshua **IGNORE** the **"SAME DAY"** clause (Lev 23:14) to align the Hebrew nation with the Enoch Calendar?

No! The FIRST PORTION of the cut grain supplied the required offering – allowing the baking and eating on Abib 15! Does Enoch's Calendar demand that a portion of this FIRST BREAD DOUGH must be retained for 11 cycles (days) to offer (wave sheaf) on Abib 26?



Do the Scriptures endorse bread 11 days old?

Week of Unleavened Bread

#### Or? ... Will Yahuah accept bread 11 cycles old?

- 1 Chron 9:32 confirms Yahuah's statute
  of limitations for the Sanctuary
   Set-Apart Bread was 7 cycles.
- The new shewbread was to be prepared every Shabbat to replace the former weeks 7 cycle old shewbread - Lev 24:8.

Remember: Bread Dough is moist and very prone to mold in a warm climate!





Is it reasonable that Yahuah would accept 11 cycle old

stale, and/or moldy

bread dough as the Wave Sheaf offering?



## **Huge Enoch Dilemma**



Enoch rightly places the Unleavened Bread Festival on Abib 15-21.

- 1. Abib 15 is the last day the manna is given (Josh 5:12).
- 2. Enoch always places Wave Sheaf on Abib 26 in this case 11 days late!
- 3. According to Torah, the grain of the land cannot be touched for any reason until after the Wave Sheaf ceremony.
- 4. How is Enoch supposed to celebrate the Feast of Unleavened Bread, (eating unleavened bread from Abib 15-21 as one of the statutes) and NOT be in violation of cutting the grain before Wave Sheaf cycle?
- 5. Is Enoch truthfully fulfilling the Torah "type" in preparation for <u>THE</u> "antitype" which represents the first heavenly ascension of Yahusha?

#### Torah Dates are Flexible

- 1. Yahusha died on a 4<sup>th</sup> cycle, not the 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- 2. Yahusha's Wave Sheaf was on Abib 18<sup>th</sup>, not Abib 26<sup>th</sup> (or even Sunday Abib 25<sup>th</sup>).

- Wave Sheaf is always outside the feast of Unleavened Bread!



## The Resurrection / First-Fruits View - #1

 After His resurrection on Shabbat Abib 17<sup>th</sup> Yahusha ascended the next Dawn (Abib 18) to His Father.

#### What was His express mission?

- As Shaul declares, in 1 Cor 15:20, 23,
   Yahusha Ha Mashiach IS the
   First-Fruit Offering of the Wave Sheaf Festival.
- This is always the 1st cycle <u>after</u> the (H7676)
  Shabbat <u>within the full 8 day festival!</u>

Did Yahusha then (on I	His 1 <sup>st</sup> ascension to Heaven – Abib <u>18</u> ) - request
a 9 cycle e	extension reaching to - Abib 26,
so He could return bac	k to His Father to complete the Wave Sheaf
offering as the First-Fr	uits from death - per the Enoch Calendar??

Did Yahusha request a 9 cycle extension to offer Himself as the First Fruit from Death, on Enoch's Abib 26th ... A "MONDAY"?

Or should the request be made for Abib 25th ... Enoch's "Sunday"?

- 2. For Joshua: His First Portion of Dough becomes seriously outdated by Abib 26?!
- 3. For Yahusha: Fulfilling Enoch's claim for First Fruit offering on Abib 26th of the month AND the 2nd cycle of the week (Monday), is surely -

# BREAKING THE STATUTES of Yahuah!

#### #5.1: Yahusha - THE Perfect Firstfruit Offering

What about Yahusha being the PERFECT offering of the Wave Sheaf fulfillment?

Yahusha the PERFECT First-Fruit, the victory over death!?



Before His 1<sup>st</sup> ascension, Yahusha, in the darkness of the 4<sup>th</sup> watch, restricted Mary Magdalene from touching Him when they met.

Yahusha could not be defiled by a human prior to presenting

Himself to Yahuah as the First–Fruit offering, the PERFECT (Exo 12:5)

**ULTIMATE SACRIFICE** to fulfill the Wave Sheaf Feast offering.

# Was Yahusha really a PERFECT Wave Sheaf offering (NOT CONTAMINATED BY HUMANS)

Yes! **PERFECTION** is important to **Yahuah!** 

**Lev 23:12** 'And on that day when you wave the sheaf, you shall prepare a male lamb <u>a year old</u>, A **PERFECT ONE**, as a burnt offering to יהוה [Yahuah],

Question:

Where in the Scriptures do we find that Yahusha took specific action to preserve Himself as the PURE First-Fruit offering for the Wave Sheaf presentation?

A second witness!

- If a human had touched (CONTAMINATED Num 19:11-16) Yahusha prior to presenting Himself as the Perfect Sacrifice –
- 1) THEN He would have been DISQUALIFIED as

the **PERFECT** Sacrifice.

- 2) THEN Yahusha would have FAILED Yahuah's Plan of Salvation.
- 3) THEN Yahusha would no longer qualify as The Mashiach!
- 4) THEN consequently by default, upon the tree when Yahusha declared "It has been accomplished," that would have been a

#### **TOTAL FALSEHOOD!**

**DISQUALIFIED?** = No Mashiach & No Salvation!

Note: Yahusha having <u>FULFILLED</u> the First Fruit offering for Wave

Sheaf at early Dawn, returned from His presentation before Yahuah.

He then readily accepted the adoration and worship

of His followers; willingly accepting their touch!

- Mark 16:2 [The ladies with their spices came at sunrise to visit the tomb].
- Matt 28:9 [The ladies departed after hearing the good news from the angel that Yahusha had risen.]
- Matt 28:9 And as they were going to report to His taught ones, see, יהושע met them, saying, "Greetings!" And they came and held Him by the feet and did bow to Him.

#### After returning from the courts of Heaven,

Yahusha could now accept physical contact from His children.

- What <u>Divine Event</u> had occurred allowing Him human touch?
- Had Yahusha already presented Himself in the courts of Heaven to Yahuah as, the PURE FIRST-FRUIT offering, fulfilling the "Anti-type" Wave Sheaf statute? (Lev 23:10-14)
- Recall this: the date of the first cycle of the week
   after His resurrection was Abib 18!

Zadok/Enoch, are you paying attention?

#### What would be the situation with Enoch & Zadok Abib 26!

At this point of Abib 18, with Yahusha being "contaminated" human touch,

He would still have 9 cycles to complete before fulfilling the

Zadok proclaimed Wave Sheaf

festival of the First-Fruit

offering on Abib 26!

Question: As Yahusha did not find it acceptable to be "contaminated" by human touch before performing the Scriptural First-Fruit offering on Abib 18 ...

# Who then could possibly have qualified as the

# **PURE FIRST-FRUIT**

offering on Enoch's Abib 26 Wave Sheaf Festival?

Or Zadok!

No <u>PURE</u> OFFERING = NO MASHIACH! No Mashiach = NO SALVATION!
