





"Light" began the first 24 hour cycle - on the 1st day until "Light" appeared again to begin the second 24 hour cycle.

Everything about Yahuah's day-start is from "light" to "light."








This issue started in the beginning before the verse of Genesis 1:1.




In heaven, before Gen 1:1, Lucifer usurped worship rightly belonging to only Yahuah.

This is known as the civil Roman Reckoning of time as found in the Gospels.

Remember, the weekly Sabbath is the premier flagship of Yahuah's festivals (Lev 23:2-8). Note there is a massive amount of information thoroughly exposed in the Scriptures which is succinctly summed up as follows:

 "To Period IIa [approx. 700-300 BC], belong those processes which practically completed the WOLUTTON of Calendar III as a perfect, or approximately perfect luni-solar calendar, viz., the CHANGE in the system of reckoning the day, the RE-DATING of the festivals to begin at sunset, and with this the final and complete fusion of the Passover and Mazzot festivals, as recorded in Exo 12:18, the NEW SYSTEM of months of alternately thirty and twenty-nine days each and the NEW SYSTEM of interediation." [Changed from Torah's Dawn to Dawn, and the Mazzaroth/Tequfah Light based calendar reckoning.]

However, Scripture reveals when the day begins and it is neither midnight, noon, sunset, evening or sunrise!



Definition

The word "day" is often misunderstood by most people.

When Moses wrote the book of Genesis, he totally understood this word "day."

In Genesis, Yahuah defined the word "day" as including both twilight transition times, of evening and morning.



#### 1st Definition for "day/yowm" is:

- the warm hours of the day
- to be hot [Day Season]

## Definitions

#### In other words:

From the beginning of morning to the end of evening [or about 12 hours or 12 segments of time.]

2nd Definition for "day/yowm" is the: full 24 hour cycle including the Day Season and the Night Season.

## The word "day/yowm" can be a confusing word to many.

According to Hebrew #3117 there are two main definitions for "DAY" in the Festal Calendar study

(that will include twilights).

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When Yahuah separated the light from the darkness, He called the light "Day" and then ... He defined that "day" as being made up of both the evening and the morning.




Both the evening & morning twilights are "mixtures" of

the "day" ~ the Light Season.



The Scriptures have provided the definitions for its calendar terms.

Concept A: Defined the terms of day, night, evening & morning.

Note: Gen1:5 has another purpose.

Concept B: To give the correct order of events as they occurred.



## Purpose #1[a]:

Correct Order of Events for the "Yowm Seasons"

Correct Order of Events for the "Twilight Season"

## Following the 1st Light Season of creating,

Next, the 2nd DAYLIGHT SEASON will contain two twilights. [Only the 1st Day has just one twilight; evening arriving first.] Beginning with Day Season 2, the morning twilight arrives first. Definitions Day Season #2 begins with "boger light" not "owr light."]

- On Day 4 does THE Son, with the sUn, have a "midst of the week" marker for our salvation?



< owr H216> is first defined as Illumination - not a luminary in the sky. This refers specifically to Yahuah supplying all the light before the sky light-givers were brought forth.




