


 King Josiah's testimony about "when the day begins" is just one of about 40 Scripture testimonies?

- Does that not mean that every testimony, and especially the story of King Josiah, must be carefully preserved for something very special for everyone to learn?




Did you know that ...

 Passover lamb sacrifices right up to the Night Season of Abib 14?


Did you know that ...
