- In the last 18 months there have been over 75,000 views for Yahuah's Covenant Calendar.
- By now a lot of people around the world are understanding Yahuah's days begin everyday with the "break of day" ~ not sunset!
- This is known as <boqer> in Hebrew.
- Boqer is "always and only" the first daylight in the sky before the sun peaks above the horizon.



• **This twilight time varies in “length of time” depending on where you live in the world.**

• **If the twilight time in your area of the world is very short, you may have been missing it all this time, so check it out!**

several Scripture testimonies

**(or the mixing of
light and night darkness),**

**but the story of Gideon
is not one of them.**





- Judges 7 tells the story of how Gideon's army of 32,000 men was reduced to a mighty 300 warriors under Yahuah's instructions.
- This is a very simple story that shows in humble detail each new day began at dawn.
- We already know there are around 40 Scripture testimonies in the Old Testament alone that confirm this same day-start truth.

And YES, every
one of these
testimonies
are meant to also
be a firm report
of Yahuah's
Covenant
of the Day
and
Covenant
of the Night!
(Jer 33:20)

That is:

... No matter
how many
secular
historical
documents
can be found
to support
sunset!

HOWEVER - Many Dawn Day Scripture testimonies do have a very special gem of information that really may not have been found UNLESS you understand the day begins with dawn. THEN you have to decide to break open every story in great detail to find that gem!






- This Gideon testimony happens to be one of the dawn-day stories that has a surprising “gem” of information.



In fact it's very interesting this “gem” is connected to the word “soliloquy” – a dramatic or literary form of discourse in which a character talks to himself revealing his thoughts when alone or unaware of the presence of others.





This “gem” also breaks open a very controversial topic of the Scriptures. Could this “gem” be connected to Yahuah’s Covenant Calendar?
