


By a child of 12 years?

This is the short version of a very detailed study called "Yahusha, Lost ... and Discovered at Passover!"

There will be an interesting "thought-provoking" comparison between:

- 1. The Covenant Calendar Yahusha honoured;
- 2. The Lunar-solar Calendar in use at that time (Yahusha at age 12) by the unbelieving Jews.



Question:

What is a Covenant Calendar?

Introduction

- 1) Covenant Calendar is first based on Torah with additional witnesses in the rest of the Old Testament.
- 2) The full and most amazing confirmation to this Covenant Calendar is found in the Gospels with very strong witnesses through Yahusha's life from conception to His gift of the Ruach upon Pentecost/Shavuot of Acts 2.
- Additional confirmation for Covenant Calendar will continue to be found with the disciples, and especially the apostle Paul.
- 4) For this study, exact year dates and festival "days and dating" are easily verified through two sources.
 - Those two sources are two very different calendars discovered in the Gospels.

Two Very Important Calendars

- The first calendar is the Lunar Based Calendar of the "unbelieving" Jews, fully verified through the research of Julian Morgenstern, 1935.
- It must be noted both the research of Morgenstern and the Gospel Covenant Calendar demonstrate the Jews were using more than one method of Lunar Calendar reckoning.
- The Gospels are the final witness to verify Morgenstern's research as accurate and correct in every detail. (This may be of interest to some!)

- The second calendar is the Covenant Calendar which aligns perfectly with Morgenstern's research AND Yahusha's ministry throughout the four Gospels.
- Because of this the calendar details in the Gospels can no longer be glossed over.
- It is time to take very careful note of everything, including any deviation from "one set of wording" to "another set of wording."
- This short study is meant to press you to think outside the box!

At 12, Yahusha, after three days – was doing WHAT?

Luke will provide crucial timing assistance in:

- determining what year Yahusha was born
- 2. determining which calendars were being used
- determining how one can know "who" was following "what" calendar
- determining where Yahusha's parents fit into this scenario
- 5. determining how & why Yahusha challenged His parents

Let's examine the "lingo of Luke" first!

The "lingo" of Luke 2 & Calendar

Covenant Lingo

- Vs 21: "Name given by the messenger"
- Vs 22: "according to the Torah"
- Vs 23: "has been written in the Torah"
- Vs 24: "what is said in the Torah"
- Vs 27: "according to the usual practice of the Torah"
- Vs 39: "according to the Torah"

Up to this point Luke specifically recorded Divine Authority through the Covenant Lingo of Torah.

Next: Does Luke deviate from his style in the SAME chapter? And does it matter?

Tradition Lingo

- Vs 41: His parents went to the "Festival of the Passover."
- Vs 42: When Yahusha was 12 years old, they went up according to "the practice of the festival."
- Questions:
- 1. Why has Luke changed his lingo to generic language such as "the Festival" instead of "the Festival according to the Torah"?
- 2. Who governed this particular "practice of the festival"?
- 3. Why was Yahusha discovered in the temple "3 days after" this "practice of the festival"? Is He really 12 years old?

Luke 1:41(a) And it came to be, when Elisheba heard the greeting of Miryam, that The Baby leaped in her womb.

What **important**DIRECT CONNECTION

does this verse have to do with -

Life begins at conception!


Luke 2:42 And when He was **twelve** years old, they went up to Yerushalayim according to the **practice** of the festival.

In short: Yahusha's <u>conception</u> is the beginning for the count to His age of 12 years for vs 42.

Yochanon's first 12 months of his life starting at conception!

Yochanon's Conception is 18 Months prior to CE 1.

This calculation is based upon the angel's announcement to Zacharias as priest at Shavuot. Passover in the 1st month of the Covenant Calendar year. (Abib)



The 4th Month of Covenant Calendar.

Remember, Covenant Calendar months are not identical to Gregorian months.

Allow for some variation in time span.

Yochanon in his 9th month, was birthed here on the 1st month just prior to Passover!

Yochanon birthed (at 9 months), here, just before Passover!

Yochanon <u>completed</u> his first year here at - 12 months!



Yahusha, being 6 months younger than Yochanon (Luke 1:36), was birthed here, in His 9th month, just before Sukkot!

Oct Nov Dec 12
Sukkot 10 11

Yahusha **COMPLETED** His 1st year of 12 months – here, in the 9th month of CC!

NOTE: - "Grand Points of Reckoning"

1st - Yochanon's birth prior to Passover

2nd - Yahusha's birth just BEFORE Sukkot

For Yahusha to be 12 years old in the year CE 12 when
He was discovered 3 cycles "later" in the Tabernacle,
He MUST FIRST be 1 year old, upon ENTERING CE 1!
This puzzle can only be solved by counting His years
from the time of conception, complimented by CE 12 !10

Yahusha - <u>conceived</u> 12 months before 1 CE, being born near Sukkot, He needed 3 more months <u>TO COMPLETE HIS FIRST YEAR</u> <u>PRIOR TO</u> CE 1! Ages

That means in the Qth month CCC

Yahusha was 1 year old, going INTO – (or)
ENTERING CE1!

That means in the 9th month CC, (end of the first year Gregorian), Yahusha turned 2 years old; and so on and so forth.

In CE 11, at the end of the Gregorian year, Yahusha completed His 12th year.


That means Yahusha was 12 years old at His first recorded Passover.

Lunar Calendar CE 12 - Passover Timing









At this time in Judah's history, the new moonth/year was calculated from the crescent moon before the tequfah.

Please note the different colours of the months. March's colour will stay the same as there is no change here. April will reveal <u>two</u> <u>different Passovers</u> – one – <u>Covenant Calendar Blue</u>, and one – <u>Lunar Calendar Beige</u>. Please notice these differences that reveal two separate calendars for your comparison on the slides to follow.

Covenant Calendar CE 12 - Passover Timing






Year Day


For Covenant Calendar, the new month/year always begins the day following the tequfah.

CE 12 is the ONLY
Covenant Calendar year
that can satisfy these Gospel requirements in conjunction with the Lunar Calendar of the unbelieving Jews.



The last 3 days of the Lunar Passover

Yahusha's presence in the Tabernacle was 3 days AFTER the completion of the Lunar Feast!

What day was this on Covenant Calendar?

On the 4th cycle of the week, [Wed] in the 1st month of Covenant Calendar

Yahusha was IN
the Tabernacle (by Statute Exo 23:15-17)
presenting Himself
[age 12] & observing the
High Shabbat of
Unleavened Bread!

Luke 2:48 When [Yahusha's] parents saw him, they were shocked. His mother asked him, "Son, why have you treated us like this? Your father and I have been worried sick looking for you!" ISV

What was Yahusha's response at being questioned?

They did not know!


