- Many people today know the symbolic 70th week of Dan 9's prophecy has something to do with pinpointing EXACTLY "Who" the true Messiah is!
 - This belief is grounded in the prophetic words "midst of the week" as the literal marker for the middle of 7 literal years. This is by using Scriptural rules to interpret prophetic timelines.

This rule is thus established by:

...I have appointed thee
each day for a year.

Ezekiel 4:6

...each day for a year.

Numbers 14:34

**Note: This rule
has nothing
to do with
7 literal days.**



Symbolic Calculation: “midst of the week” (middle)



- The symbolic meaning for the phrase “**midst of the week**” is usually understood as the “**middle marker of time**” in a 7 year period, when the rule for a symbolic prophecy is applied – as “**1 symbolic day = 1 literal year.**” Thus:
- **7 symbolic days = 7 literal years.**
- Then the “midst of this literal 7 years” will be at the 3½ year marker where **Yahusha** was to be “cut off.”

However, this study is not about that!

- Many, many people in the world today believe the Saviour laid down His life on what is now called “Good Friday.”
- That is the false messiah, and ...

- IF our Messiah's death is married to a Good Friday, how can the 6th day/cycle be understood as the literal “midst of the week”?

Symbolic Meaning: “midst of the week”

- Many believe that **Yahusha** died after His ministry of **3½** years. However this is not true either! According to Exodus 12, the Passover lamb was to be “**of the first year.**” In other words, between the age of 1-2 years.
- This **3½** cannot be interpreted to indicate our Saviour, as “the true last Passover Sacrifice.” He did not have a ministry of 3½ years making Him **33½** years old.
- Studies have shown He offered His life between the young age of 30-31 years.

- The **2nd application** of Daniel 9:27 is around **Yahusha's** death on **His Covenant** Passover festival.

Which option will arrive at the exact "midst of the week" when Vahusha's sacrifice ceased?

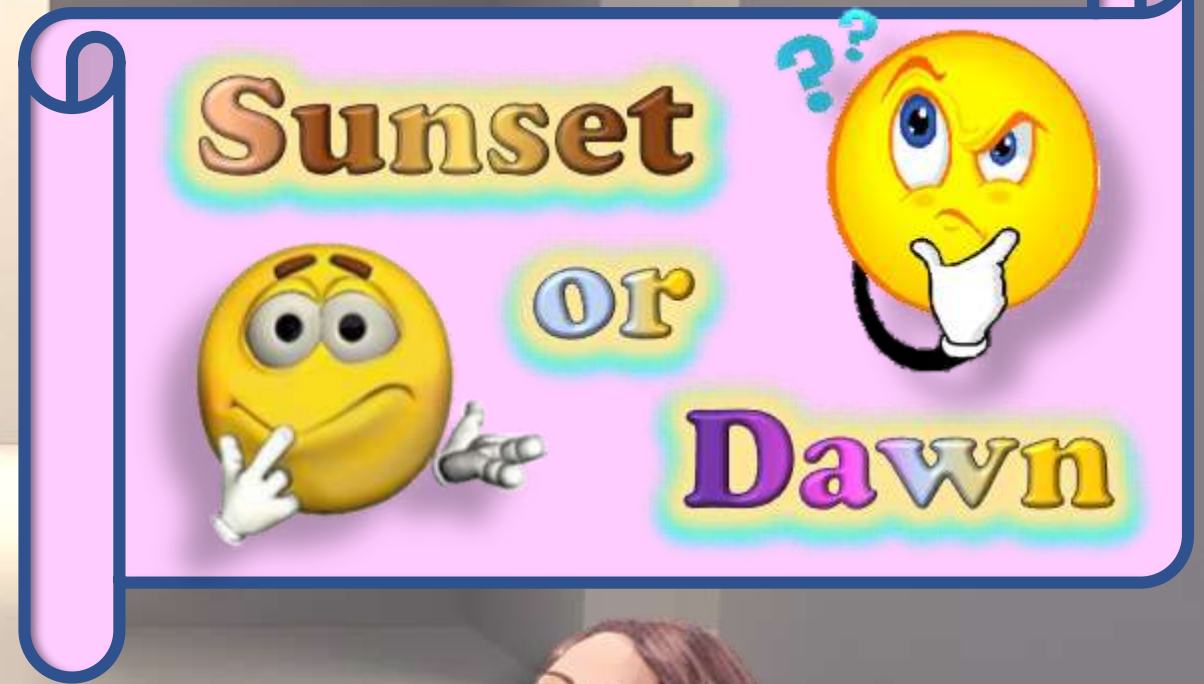
