

4. Creation Moon; Hezekiah's miracle altered the moon cycle 3300 years after creation; moon will be restored in the new Earth.




1) Sidereal Month: (aligns with the stars)

- The time it takes for the moon to complete one orbit of Earth; an average of 27.3 days.

2) Synodic Month: (aligns with the sun)

- The time it takes for the moon to reach the same visual phase; an average of 29.5 days or 29 phases.



Lunar Roots of the Jewish Calendar

- The Jews adopted the Babylonian calendar dates from the period of their Babylonian Exile in the 6th century B.C.
- This 19-year lunar cycle became known as the Metonic cycle, and was the basis for the Greek calendar until the Roman Julian calendar was introduced in 46 BC.
- This calendar has deep roots in several pagan nations all requiring a 13th month.

What About “LIGHT” in Yahuah?

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The **Creator**, Who is **LIGHT** and created light, dwells in unapproachable **LIGHT**!

1 Tim 6:15-16 He who is the blessed and only Potentate, the Sovereign of sovereigns and Master of masters, 16 who alone has immortality, dwelling in unapproachable light, whom no man has seen or can see.
NKJV [with use of Sacred Titles]

1 John 1:5 This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that Yahuah is light, and in him is no darkness at all. *KJV*

What About “Light” in Lucifer?

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There was a sense of brightness around **Lucifer**.

Isa 14:12 ... Lucifer, son of the morning! *KJV*

Lucifer - **H1966**; heylel; from **H1984** (in the sense of brightness); the morning-star: *KJV* - **lucifer** (the king of Babylon).

- ❖ **H1984** halal; a primitive root; **to be clear** (orig. **of sound**, but usually **of color**); **to shine**; hence, to make a show, **to boast**; and thus to be (clamorously) foolish; to rave; causatively, to celebrate; also to stultify.

Understanding H3391

- **H3391**: is the root word for the set of family words between H3391-H3394.

Note:

1. The definition of the root word is the most important.
2. The 1st definition of H3391 is: **lunation** [or the cycle] - not "moon" and not "month."
3. "Lunation" is always linked to the "moon."
4. The sun and stars have cycles, but they are not called "lunations."



Understanding “Lunation”

From: *The Heritage Illustrated Dictionary of the English Language.*

- **Lunation**: The time elapsing between two successive new moons, averaging 29 days, 12 hrs., 44 min., 28 sec. From Latin *luna*, moon. See lunar.

lu·na·tion (lōō-nā'shən) *n.* The time elapsing between two successive new moons, averaging 29 days, 12 hours, 44 minutes, 28 seconds. [Middle English *lunacioun*, from Medieval Latin *lūnātiō*, from Latin *lūna*, moon. See lunar.]



Understanding “Lunar”

From: *The Heritage Illustrated Dictionary of the English Language.*

- **Lunar:** of, involving, caused by, or affecting the moon. Measured by the revolution [cycle] of the moon: *a lunar month; a lunar year.* [Then it says:]
See leuk- in Appendix.*



lu-nar (lōō'nər) *adj.* 1. Of, involving, caused by, or affecting the moon. 2. Measured by the revolution of the moon: *a lunar month; a lunar year.* 3. Of or relating to silver. [Latin *lūnāris*, from *lūna*, moon. See leuk- in Appendix.*]

The word “leuk” will be examined shortly.

Understanding “Leuk’s” Connection to Lunar

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- Note: “Leuk” is connected to both “lunar” [literal moon] and “lunation” [moon’s cycle]. (See slides #37 - #38.)




The **MOON** has no “light” of its own.
(Remember Isa 13:10 re: “masculine moon.”)
The sun gives the moon its brightness.

But, the moon has always had its own
lunar cycle since creation.

This cycle began with a perfect 30 day length.

Question: Was it Yahuah’s purpose to allow
Sidereal and Synodic months of different lengths?



Understanding “*Leuk*’s” Connection to Lucifer

Leuk - (comes from the words lunar & luration) meaning “**light**” or “**brightness.**”

In **Latin** the word “*leuk*” is *lux*, meaning: **Lucifer!**

Review of *Leuk* Definition

Note the comparisons for *Leuk*!

Leuk - The suffixed form in Old English is light:

1. In *Latin*, light = Lucifer. 
2. Suffixed form of *lumen* in Latin = luminous; illuminate.
3. Suffixed form of *luna*, in Latin =  moon: lunar, lunate, lunatic, ... etc.!



An investigation on “luna” will follow shortly.

What does all of this have to do with H3391's "lunation cycle" & H3394's "literal moon"?

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Lucifer's light came from "the Son."

Moon = lunar, lunation, leuk & [borrowed] brightness. Is **the MOON** connected to Satan through "darkness"?



The **moon** is dark until it receives light reflected from the sun.

- **G4582** selene; from selas (brilliancy; probably akin to the alternate of G138, through the idea of attractiveness); the moon.




The Lunar Month (a Review)



- The Lunar month [H3391] was designed for agricultural ordinances.
- However the ordinances of the lunar month were ex-changed by sinful man and substituted for the commencement of pagan worship statutes; giving homage to the pagan moon god.
- After the sundial event [~ 700 BC] the lunation cycle changed from 30 days/month to an average of 27.3 [Sidereal] days/month. The Metonic Cycle stretched the lunar month to about 29.5 [Synodic] days/month!!
[This is from "phase to phase" which extends beyond the completed cycle.]
- When **H3391** is used ... it is usually connected to the moon's original creation week lunar month of 30 days.
- At creation, both types of months had 30 days each.

DEUTERONOMY 21:13

NUMBERS 10:10

PSALM 81:3

Now that we know ...

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- **H3391** has the "verb/action" meaning of the **moon's cycle**;
- The moon month from creation also started out **with 30 days**;
- Lunar & lunation **connect to the words Lucifer and moon ...**
We are now ready to examine the next point.
- **Question:** Does **H3391** as the "moon month" ever refer to Yahuah's 30 day creation month? Why?
- Because the *Englishman's Concordance* lists **H3391** as "month" [rather than moon's lunation] in Deut 21:13. Let's examine this tricky problem.



Are These Scriptures Synonymous?

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Ps 81:3 – Blow the trumpet in the **new moon** ... (H2320)

Num 10:10 – Blow the trumpet in the **beginning of the month**. (H2320)

Deut 21:13 – Bewail her family for **a full month**. (H3391)

Is this H3391 month the same as Yahuah's set-apart month?

Do these 3 Scriptures support the “[new] moon-month” being in alignment with Yahuah's set-apart month?





Scrutinizing Deut 21:13

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- ❖ This Torah verse is often used to prove that a lunar month is identical to Yahuah's original set-apart H2320 month for feast worship statutes.

Deut 21:13 And she shall put the raiment of her captivity from off her, and shall remain in thine house, and bewail her father and her mother **a full month** [H3391].

- When a maiden was taken into captivity she was allowed one month to mourn for her family.
- Captivity could occur on any day of either Yahuah's set-apart month, or the moon/month.
- It would be easy for the pagan maiden to calculate the full 30 days by following the H3391 lunar cycle from sliver to sliver; one full moon to the next; or any phase in between. H3391 is the best choice for the context.

Yahuah's Regard for the Pagan Captive

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- When Israel raided the pagan nations, taking captive maids, it would be very unusual for the maidens to not already follow the moon cycle system of counting.
- Yahuah was very sympathetic towards captured maidens. They were to receive every Torah benefit.
- In this way she could confidently count out her rightful days of mourning [through the moon phases] before being subjected to her captor, before her allotted time.
- Later, the captives would learn of Yahuah's worship Covenant Calendar.

A) Comparing Num 10:10 to Deut 21:13

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Num 10:10 (Torah)

- **Num 10:10** Also in the day of your gladness, and in your solemn days, and in the beginnings of **your months** [H2320] ye shall blow with the trumpets ...

Deut 21:13 (Torah)

- **Deut 21:13** And she shall put the raiment of her captivity from off her, and shall remain in thine house, and bewail her father and her mother **a full month** [H3391].

Both months of H2320 & H3391
appear to be synonyms.



#1 Puzzle Solving: Num 10 & Deut 21



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Num 10:10 (Torah)

The wording is given as “blow the trumpet at the **beginning** of the month [H2320].”

Deut 21:13 (Torah)

The wording is given as “a **full** lunar month [H3391]” for mourning of captivity.

Both Numbers 10 and Deuteronomy 21 are referring to very different months.

Num. [trumpet] “month” = H2320 – the “renewing” month of Yahuah with roots in **Day 1** of Creation.



Deut. [captivity] “month” = H3391 – the lunation month of Yahuah with roots in **Day 4** of Creation.

Num 10 and Deut 21 do NOT fit together!!
Yahuah’s H2320 month is never the same as the H3391 Lunar month.





B) Comparing Num 10:10 to Psa 81:3

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Num 10:10 (Torah)

- **Num 10:10** Also in the day of your gladness, and in your solemn days, and in the beginnings of **your months** [H2320] ye shall blow with the trumpets ...

“new month” &
“new moon”

Psalms 81:3 (non-Torah)

- **Ps 81:3** Blow up the trumpet in the new **moon** [H2320], in the time appointed on our solemn feast day.



... both appear to be synonyms. Are they?



A Closer Look at Num 10:10 & Psa 81:3


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Num 10:10 & Psa 81:3 give instructions for when the trumpets are blown. The context is not about one specific time on one specific day!

They were to blow the trumpets at these times:

1. On the 1st day of every new month [H2320] (for counting worship statutes);
2. At the fullness of the solemn holy feast days - when they are fully come;
3. On every feast day during the feast weeks.

Will Numbers 10 and
Psalm 81 agree
to fit together?



#2 Puzzle Solving: Num 10 & Psa 81



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Num 10:10 (Torah)

The wording is given as
“beginning of your **month**.”

“**month**” = H2320

Psalms 81:3 (non-Torah)

The wording is given as
“new moon [**H2320**].”

“~~moon~~” should be “**month**”
[when translated properly – more work on this later.]



Both Num 10 and Psalms 81 are referring to the same H2320 “set-apart month” of 30 days, or Yahuah’s month that began on the 1st day of creation. The months of Psalms & Numbers are not linked to the moon.



Scrutinizing Psalm 81:3 & Num 10:10

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- ❖ **Psa 81:3** Blow up the trumpet in the new ~~moon~~ month [H2320; renewal of 1st day of Yahuah's month], **in the time appointed** [H3677; fullness], **on our solemn feast day** [H2282; every festival].
- ✓ **Psa 81:3** must follow the Torah instructions given by Moses.
- ❖ **Num 10:10** Also in the day of your gladness, and in your solemn days, and in the beginnings of your months [H2320; not H3391 lunar month], ye shall blow with the trumpets ...

Between Psa 81:3 & Num 10:10
there is no mention of H3391.

H3391 never qualifies any lunar phase
to commence Yahuah's feast months.

Psalm 81 & Numbers 10 do agree! This puzzle is solved!



H3391 Final Conclusion <yerach>

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The
H3391
MOON
does not
commence
Yahuah's
Festal
month.

- Deut 33:14 is the very first H3391 Torah reference that aligns with a moon/month of 30 days (as are 11 of the 13 verses).
- For 3300 years the "moon/month" had 30 days in its cycle (which began its commencement on the 4th day of creation week).
- Not one H3391 moon/month reference gives instruction to commence Yahuah's set-apart month.
- Only 2 references use the word MOON instead of MONTH referring to the agricultural or prophetic aspect of the MOON.
- However, not one of the <13> H3391 verses lends any support for the set-apart month to commence with any phase of the MOON in the sky.

H3391 Final Conclusion (Con't)

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The
H3391
MOON
does not
align with
Yahuah's
Festal
month.

H3391 means the actual lunation or
"cycle of the moon" in any "moon month."

And that's all!

Up until the sundial event, the moon month
and set-apart month, both had 30 days.

But, they did NOT commence on the same day!

Definition: "seasons" [H2166]

- ❖ **seasons** H2166 zeman (Aramaic); from H2165; the same as H2165: KJV - season, time.
- ❖ H2165 zeman; from H2163; an appointed occasion: KJV - season, time.
- ❖ **H2163 zaman (zaw-man')**; a primitive root; to fix (a time): KJV - appoint.

When did Yahuah change any "seasons" or appointed times?

Dan 2:21

And he changeth the times [5732] and the seasons: [2166] he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding.



Definition: "times" [H5732]

- ❖ **times** H5732; `iddan (Aramaic); from a root corresponding to that of H5708; a set time; technically, a year: KJV - time.
- ❖ H5708 `ed ; from an unused root meaning to set a period [compare H5710, H5749]; the menstrual flux (as periodical); by implication (in plural) soiling: KJV - filthy.

How did Yahuah change any "times" to became soiled/filthy?

Dan 2:21

And he changeth the times [5732] and the seasons: [2166] he removeth kings, and setteth up kings.
